


The History

The Kanbi ancestors came from Baluchistan to Punjab to Haryana (Kurushetra) to Rajasthan and arrived in Gujarat in approximately AD 1200. Leva and Kadva Patels then simply known as Kunbi's Journeyed together. From North Gujarat one branch headed South (Naliyad, Baroda) the second branch headed towards Banas Kantha, Saurashtra, and Kutch. In those days surname went according to trade. The clan surname was Butani, but once feeding the village (Jaman) with makhan and ghee, (Goras), the clan was then called GORASIA.

Kunverji Devsi Gorasia, Moved from Meghpar, to Baladia in AD 1846 (VS 1902). He passed away in AD 1852. His widow Nanbai moved to Madhapur in 1858 (this was when Madhapur, established a sub-colony which was then called Ravapar, and now is known as Navavas) with sons Devji, Murji, Bhimji and Petha.

Clan Mataji (mothergoddess) is Khodiyar Bhramani Satiyar Surdhen Shehtrapal. Her Math (shrine) still exists at the village of Jagga (Address: Patel Naran Murji Gorasia, Post Jagga Medi via Jamvanthal, district Jamnagar, pin 361130.) Details supplied by Velji Murji, Sukhpar.

Even today many Gorasia live in the villages of Jagga and Bhatia.
